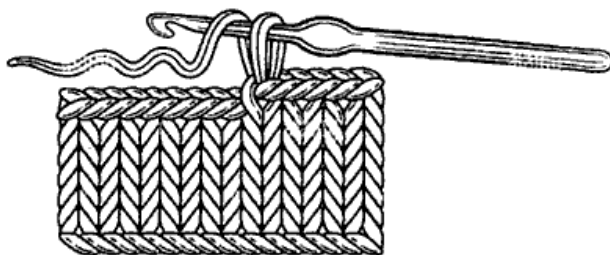

- (b) Write a short note on this costume. [3]

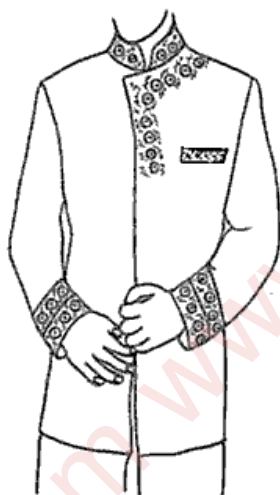
Question 7
