- (b) Bhoothamasrayami – Nattaikurinji – Thampi – Muthuswamy Dikshitar
- (c) Anupama Gunambudhi – Atana – K. Chapu – Thyagarajar
- (d) Venu Ganaloluni – Kedaragoula – Roopakam - Thyagarajar
