This body was established in Delhi on the 1st of September 1961. Its main objective is to help the Central Government in matters of school education in the context of a comprehensive policy and in implementing educational schemes. The NCERT was given the responsibility of educational research and development, training, extension , educational programmes, restructuring of school curriculum and text books. It has played a central role in designing School curricula and text books with the Corporation Of The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). It provides guidance and Corporation in the area of primary and secondary education to the state government. It has been involved in designing workbooks and hand books for teachers ,in teachers training, in developing teaching -learning techniques and conducting talent search examination at the national level . SCERTs were established in all states on the line of the NCERT”
